2nd GRAND CRU CLASSE IN 1855 - SAINT-JULIEN



- Second Grand Cru Classé in 1855 in Saint-Julien, considered as a “Super Second”
- Owned by the Borie family for three generations
- Owes its name to its beautiful pebbles (beaux Cailloux in French) that geologists refer to Gunzian gravel
- A very dynamic and innovative estate, one of the top brands in Bordeaux with consistent scoring at the top of the hierarchy
