2ND GRAND CRU CLASSE EN 1855 – SAINT-JULIEN

- Iconic Second Grand Cru Classé in 1855 in Saint-Julien, defined as a “Super Second” thanks to its amazing quality and consistency
- A historic property, owned by the same family since 1901, the Delon family (Clos du Marquis, Ch. Nénin, Ch. Potensac)
- An exceptional terroir, a vineyard in a clos, 8 soil profiles and more than 54 different subsoils
- A new state-of-the-art vinification and ageing cellar are being built
