- 3<sup>rd</sup> Grand Cru Classé in 1855 in Margaux
- One the most remarkable estates in the Médoc region, with a Tudor-style château, founded over 200 years ago by a Scottish man, John-Lewis Brown
- A property in the midst of a notable renaissance, owned by the Le Lous family & managed by José Sanfins
- An impressive new zero-carbon and eco-sustainable cellar in raw earth and wood
- The vineyard is located on Margaux and Cantenac prestigious plateaux and is surrounded by a sanctuary of biodiversity, an impressive arboretum initially planted by the founder
