

CHATEAU COS D'ESTOURNEL 2024

**2nd CLASSIFIED GROWTH IN 1855 -
SAINT-ESTÈPHE**

- Founded in the early 19th century by Louis-Gaspard d'Estournel, known as the “Maharajah of Saint-Estèphe” for his exotic vision and early success in exporting to India
- Property since 2000 of Michel Reybier, Cos d'Estournel pursues its destiny, between audacity and humility
- The Cos d'Estournel terroir benefits from a privileged geographical position, in the heart of a hilly area of Northern Médoc. The origin of the name Cos, meaning hill of stones in old Gascon, perfectly reflects this situation
