- Grand Cru Classé in 1855 in the prestigious Saint-Julien appellation
- Owned by the same family for more than 100 years: the Bignon-Cordier family, who also owns Château Sénéjac
- One of the most famous properties in the Médoc, a reputation due to the amazing regularity of its wine
- A 94 ha and single block vineyard, one of the largest in the Médoc
- An impressive vat room, inaugurated in 2012, an exceptional architectural achievement
