1^{ER} GRAND CRU CLASSE - SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU



- Ever since the beginning of the classification in 1956, Clos Fourtet has been a member of the elite “Premiers Grands Crus Classés” of Saint-Émilion
- A family estate acquired in 2001 by the Cuvelier family
- The 20-hectare vineyard forms a single plot, planted upon the highest slopes of Western Saint-Émilion, next to Château Canon
- A cavernous 13-hectare underground cave network weaves far and wide beneath the vineyards of Clos Fourtet, with a mysterious, elusive history of its own.
