GRAND CRU CLASSE DE GRAVES - PESSAC-LEOGNAN

- A prestigious Grand Cru Classé de Graves, in the Pessac Léognan appellation.
- “Cru exceptionnel” in the presentation by Henri Guillier (XXth century), alongside Ch. D’Yquem, Château Ausone etc.
- In the Top20 of the best rated wines on Left Bank for the last 10 years
- A family-owned estate, purchased in 1998 by the American Robert Wilmers with his French wife Elisabeth, the property is now led by the second generation of children
- A single block of 30-ha vineyard located on one of the highest hillocks of the Left Bank.
- In 2020 a new impressive cellar: natural beauty and elegance, an extension of the vineyard and the garden
