

CHATEAU LYNCH-BAGES 2024 GRAND CRU CLASSE EN 1855 - PAUILLAC

- Grand Cru Classé in 1855 and a reference in Pauillac, with a strong brand awareness
- Owned by the Cazes family (Ch. Haut-Batailley, Château Ormes de Pez), an emblematic family of the Medoc
- From 2006, restructuration of the vineyard. Today about 250 sub-parcels have been identified to work with even more precision.
- 2021: a new and impressive cellar is revealed, designed by the architect Didi Pei, after 4 years of renovation of the wine making facilities
