

CHATEAU LEOVILLE BARTON 2024

2ND GRAND CRU CLASSE EN 1855 - SAINT-JULIEN

- Prestigious Grand Cru Classé in 1855 in Saint-Julien
- The estate belongs to the Barton family, who acquired it in 1826
- Only 3 chateaux are still in the same family since the classification in 1855 (Léoville Barton, Langoa Barton, Mouton Rothschild)
- 50 hectares on deep gravels on clay subsoils
- A new winery since the 2022 vintage, permitting a more precise, parcel-by-parcel winemaking
