2ND GRAND CRU CLASSE IN 1855 – SAINT-ESTEPHE

- A prestigious Grand Cru Classé in 1855, a flagship in the Saint-Estèphe appellation considered as a « Super-Second »
- Martin and Olivier Bouygues acquired Château Montrose in 2006
- One the most privileged wine-growing terroirs in the Bordeaux region. The 95-ha vineyard has the exceptional and very rare particularity of being historically in one piece, around the Château and the winemaking facilities
- Since 2023: a resolute return to the origins of Montrose terroir: the grand vin is sourced entirely from Terrace 4, the unique terroir at the heart of the historic estate.
